Monday 5th March – Whole school Lea Green Activity Morning.

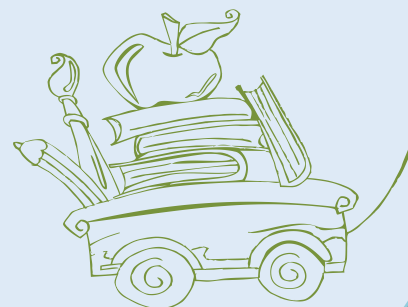

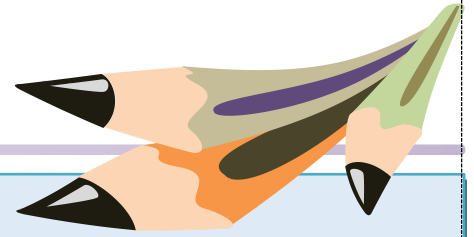
