

## Tool Talk

This is a sheath knife.

This is its handle.

This is its blade.

When I stand with a sheath knife – I stand like this.

When I walk with a sheath knife – I walk like this.

When I pass a sheath knife across - I pass it across like this.

When I'm not using a sheath knife I put it down with the handle facing forward and the blade facing in.

A sheath knife is used for whittling wood and cutting string. \*

When I use a sheath knife I use it two arms' length and a tool length away from everybody else.

When I've finished with a sheath knife I put it back in the box.

\*bill hook – cleaving wood

\* auger – drilling holes

\* secateurs – cutting wood up to the size of a pencil

\* loppers – cutting wood larger than a pencil but smaller than a 10p piece

\* bow saw – cutting wood larger than a 10p piece

\* panel saw – cutting larger pieces of wood and planks
